Increase Access in Registered Apprenticeship (RA). LPE conducted outreach with veteran-serving organizations in targeted states and facilitated the development of veteran workplans with employers and RA sponsors. Technical Assistance (TA) included collaborating with unions to support their veterans' efforts related to new apprentices and potential recruits. We also developed and published a brief titled "Strengthening the Workforce with Veterans" for employers on why they should hire veterans in supply chain automation, and "Registered Apprenticeship: Benefits to Veterans" for veterans considering a civilian career in the supply chain sector.

LPE plays a significant role in promoting Registered Apprenticeship (RA) programs for the early childhood education (ECE) workforce as an Industry Intermediary. In addition to providing outreach and technical assistance, the LPE team contributes to project management, RA subject matter expertise, and project coordination. LPE supports developing, registering, and launching high-quality, supportive RA programs. LPE leads the outreach and education to communicate the economic imperative of early childhood education to all industries and how RA is a strategy to uplift the ECE workforce.

LPE successfully transitioned the Magnet Schools Assistance Program (MSAP) Center into the Schools Technical Assistance (TA) Center, expanding its technical assistance reach to 97 MSAP and FDS grantees and the broader public. LPE assumed full management of the MSAP Center website, maintaining both its public-facing resources and a secure private section for grantee reporting. We also convened a Technical Working Group (TWG) of 12 national experts in school integration, facilitating strategic discussions and implementing a communication cycle to ensure their input shaped ongoing support. To inform our approach, we conducted a comprehensive needs assessment through discussion panels, one-on-one interviews, surveys with a 60% response rate, and document reviews, resulting in a data-driven technical assistance plan.
